

Retrace your steps back to the entrance gate and go up to Carters Lane. Proceed down the lane and on reaching Old Woking Road turn right. Take the third left into Palace Way. At the end of the road go through the park for 20m and then turn sharp right into Winston Way, then along Fairfax Road. At the end of the road turn right into Coniston Road and then take the footpath around the east and north of St John's School playing fields. At the end of the playing field go right and immediately left proceeding a short distance before turning right on Queen Elizabeth Way. At the end go right for a very short distance along Elmbridge Lane and then right up an un-named road. Pass the Leisure Centre 5-a-side pitches and at Woking Skate Park turn right into Woking Park. Cross the bridge and bear right. Leave the park at the black gates, turn left and head up White Rose Lane. Cross three roads with care and you will return to Woking Station's main entrance.

If you wish to visit the Hoebridge Golf Club clubhouse for refreshments, instead of turning left down Palace Way proceed straight on and turn right into the drive for Hoebridge Golf Club. Retrace your steps and rejoin the route by turning right into Palace Way.

Woking Station to Woking palace

A walk to the ruins of the Tudor Mansion of Woking Palace in the meadows to the east of Old Woking, alongside the River Hoe

Distance: About 6.5km (4 miles)

Time: Approximately 2 hours

Going: Flat and good except on site
